Early Life and Foundation

Born on January 28, 1959, in Lafayette, Louisiana, Pastor Walter August, Jr. was raised in the closeknit community of Abbeville, where he developed the strong values that would later guide his ministry. After completing his education in the Vermilion Parish School System and graduating from high school in 1977, he demonstrated his commitment to service by enlisting in the United States Marine Corps, where he served with distinction until 1983.

Professional Journey

Following his military service, Pastor August transitioned into the corporate world in 1984, joining First City Bank Corporate Security Group. His dedication to excellence led him to complete Professional Management Training School, earning him the position of Security Specialist in 1991. He later advanced his career at LaSalle Partners Asset Management Company, where he served as Director of Security through 1996.

Divine Calling and Ministry Beginnings

The year 1992 marked a transformative moment in Pastor August's life when God began revealing His divine purpose. Under the spiritual mentorship of Dr. E.L. Lott, Senior Pastor of True Light Missionary Baptist Church in Houston, Pastor August embraced his calling to gospel ministry. This spiritual awakening would reshape not only his own life but the lives of thousands in the Houston community.

Founding Bethel's Family

In 1994, guided by divine vision, Pastor August took a leap of faith and founded Bethel Family Baptist Church alongside his wife, three sons, and six committed adults. What began as a small congregation has flourished into a thriving ministry serving over 4,000 families through 50 diverse ministries. The church's remarkable growth reflects Pastor August's heart for community and his ability to inspire others to serve.

Before fully committing to Bethel's Family, Pastor August honed his pastoral skills serving 7½ years as Missions Pastor at Sugar Creek Baptist Church. This experience prepared him for the full-time leadership role he would assume at Bethel's Family in 2004, a pivotal year that saw the ministry flourish under his dedicated guidance.

Global Impact and Mission Work

Pastor August's vision extends far beyond Houston's borders. Through his visionary leadership, over 4,000 people have participated in international missions to countries including Belize, India, Angola, Kenya, South Africa, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Costa Rica, Haiti, and the Czech Republic. These missions encompass evangelism training, medical clinics, advanced biblical studies, and church leadership development, demonstrating his commitment to building God's kingdom worldwide.

Educational Achievements

Committed to continuous learning and spiritual growth, Pastor August attended Southwestern Theological Seminary in Houston. His dedication to ministry and community service has been recognized through Honorary Doctorates of Divinity from Alliance Theological Seminary, Saint Thomas Christian College, and Encourager Bible College & Seminary.

Community Outreach and Social Impact

Pastor August's heart for service extends beyond the church walls through numerous community initiatives:

- **Bethel's Heavenly Hands Food Pantry** (established 2003) serves over 14,000 people monthly with grocery distribution, clothing vouchers, and essential social services, addressing critical needs in the Houston community.
- **Bethel's Place** (established 2006) operates as a separate 501(c)3 Community Development and Empowerment Center, serving over 4,000 people weekly and demonstrating Pastor August's commitment to holistic community development.
- **Bethel's Family Christian Academy** (opened 2010) provides a faith-based educational environment for young families, offering quality instruction rooted in Christian values.

Expanding Vision and Recent Projects

In 2021, Pastor August's vision expanded to his Louisiana roots with the establishment of "The Nehemiah Projects of Acadiana" in Abbeville. This non-profit organization empowers community residents to transform their lives and overcome societal challenges.

Most recently, in 2024, Pastor August led an investment group in developing an ambitious \$49 million, 251-unit multi-housing project in Southwest Houston, scheduled for completion in 2027. This development will provide quality housing with modern amenities, further demonstrating his commitment to community improvement.

Disaster Response Leadership

True to his calling as a servant leader, Pastor August has positioned Bethel's Family on the frontline of disaster response throughout the greater Houston Metroplex. His church's rapid mobilization during crises reflects his understanding that faith must be accompanied by action in times of need.

Family Life

Pastor August's ministry is deeply supported by his family foundation. He has been joyfully married to Ruby Jewel for nearly 38 years, and together they have raised three sons: Walter III (married to Tanecia), Patrick, and Alex (married to Marcie). Their family has been blessed with 12 grandchildren, providing Pastor August with continued inspiration and motivation for his community work.

Legacy of Service

From his humble beginnings in Abbeville to his current role leading a multi-thousand member congregation and numerous community initiatives, Pastor Walter August, Jr. exemplifies servant leadership. His journey from Marine to corporate security professional to transformational pastor demonstrates how God can use diverse experiences to prepare individuals for extraordinary ministry. Through his work, thousands have found spiritual direction, practical assistance, and hope for the future, establishing a legacy that continues to impact communities locally and globally.


