IMPORTANT FORMS

The required forms, two release forms and a medication form (if sending meds), **MUST** be completed prior to students getting on the bus. The link to the forms will be included in the confirmation email that you receive after registering for the Hike. The registration process is not considered final until the release form is submitted.

EVENT SCHOLARSHIPS

We believe many of a student's greatest **spiritual milestones** happen through retreats, camps, conferences, and special events. These experiences provide opportunities for students to encounter God, deepen their faith, build Christ-centered friendships, and take meaningful next steps in discovering who they are in Christ.

We understand that financial challenges can make attending these events difficult for some families. Because we never want finances to prevent a student from experiencing what God may want to do in their life, Sugar Creek has established a **limited** scholarship fund to assist families experiencing financial hardship.

We simply ask that you prayerfully consider your family's circumstances, remembering that these funds are limited and not intended to be an annual thing. Those with the greatest financial need will be considered.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Scholarships are applied to the **regular event rate**, as this reflects the actual cost of the event. **If you submit a scholarship request on or near the regular registration deadline, we cannot guarantee that your application will be reviewed before registration closes. We encourage families to apply as early as possible to allow adequate time for the review process.** If you have not received a response within two weeks, please contact our Student Ministry office at students@sugarcreek.net. **The deadline for submitting a scholarship request is December 6.** Our heart is for every student to have the opportunity to experience these life-changing moments, regardless of financial circumstances. Thank you for partnering with us as we help students discover who they are in Christ, grow in their faith, and become lifelong followers of Jesus. REFUND POLICY

We fully understand that the unexpected can happen and a student who has registered and paid for an event may no longer be able to attend. Refunds may be requested and given according to the registration period that the request is made. If a refund is requested during the Early Bird Registration dates (September 27 – October 25, 2026), a 50% refund can be issued. If a refund is requested during the Regular Registration dates (October 26– December 13, 2026), a 25% refund can be issued. Once registration is closed (December 13, 2026), refunds will not be issued. All refunds must be requested via email to students@sugarcreek.net.

MEDICATION

- All prescription and non-prescription medication will be administered by our Event Nurse and will need to be turned in at check-in.
- All medications need to be in the original bottle with **only the quantity** needed and placed in a sandwich size, clear zip lock bag.
- The medication and medication form (see “important forms” section) will need to be turned to the Event Nurse at check-in on the day of the event.
- Any student found in possession of medication that was not checked-in (prescribed or unprescribed) could be sent home immediately.

DIETARY RESTRICTIONS

- Cho-Yeh can accommodate gluten-free, dairy-free, and vegetarian diets. They also operate a nut-free kitchen. There is a fridge, pantry, and microwave in the Dining Hall for those that may need to bring food to supplement. PLEASE communicate by email to students@sugarcreek.net if your child has dietary restrictions requiring food to be sent to camp.

MEALS & MERCH

- Everyone attending The Hike will need to eat dinner before arriving at check-in on Friday, January 8th.
- During registration, students can order an add-on retreat shirt if they wish, but it's important to note that shirts are available on a first-come, first-served basis while supplies and sizes last.
- If students wish to purchase any additional food, snacks, or other Student Ministry merch, they will need additional spending money.
- Pro-tip: If you're sending extra money with your student, consider giving them a pre-paid Visa, Mastercard, or American Express card, and make sure their name is written on it. We will accept card payments at The Hike, and pre-paid cards will help students avoid losing their spending money. However, please note that students will not be able to use third-party bank apps like CashApp, Venmo, Zelle, or PayPal to purchase merch at The Hike.

TRAVEL

All travel times are approximate and may vary depending on traffic to our destinations. For student travel, we typically subcontract charter buses. Drop-off will take place at **SCBC Main Campus** in Sugar Land, Texas and pick-up will take place at **SCBC Sugar Land Chapel**.

- Tobacco, e-cigarettes, alcohol, drugs of any kind, etc.
- Knives, guns, spears, harpoons, weapons of any kind, etc.
- Small armies, large armies, plans to take over the world... unless you plan to take over the world for Jesus

RULES

These rules are not in place to bore students, but to ensure that they get the most out of their experience

- Honor all staff, adult leaders, and students
- No PDA (public OR private displays of affection)
- No cell phones
- No drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, weapons, water guns, water balloons, silly string, pranks, etc.
- Do not leave camp property for any reason
- When walking from place-to-place travel in groups of four or more
- Do not touch another student's belongings without the owner's permission
- Do not go into any small group room that isn't yours
- No girls in boys' rooms and no boys in girls' rooms
- No leaving rooms after "lights out" or 11:00 PM

BEHAVIORS THAT COULD LEAD TO REMOVAL FROM EVENT

1. Stealing
2. Destruction of property
3. Assault on another student or staffer
4. Foul language
5. Repeated disobedience to rules
6. Sexual activity of any kind
7. The possession of drugs, alcohol, firearms, fireworks, or pornography
8. Improper use of any mobile device
9. Girls in boys' rooms and boys in girls' rooms
