EVENT SCHOLARSHIPS

We understand that asking for help in difficult times can be hard, but we don't want finances to be a reason a student can't attend The Hike. If you need a scholarship, [click here](#) to access our scholarship request form. Within 7-10 Business days of filling out the form, someone from our student team will be in contact with you. We do have a limited number of scholarships so please be mindful of others who may have a greater need for financial assistance. The final day to apply for scholarship is December 15th.

REFUND POLICY

We fully understand that the unexpected can happen and a student who has registered and paid for an event may no longer be able to attend. Refunds may be requested and given according to the registration period that the request is made. If a refund is requested during the Early Bird Registration dates (October 6 – October 27, 2024), a 50% refund can be issued. If a refund is requested during the Regular Registration dates (November 3 – December 15, 2024), a 25% refund can be issued. Once registration is closed (December 15, 2024), refunds will not be issued.

MEDICATION

All prescription and non-prescription medications will be administered by our Event Nurse and must be registered at check-in. All medications should be in their original bottles, with only the necessary quantity, and placed in a sandwich-sized, clear Ziplock bag. The medication and the medication form must be turned into the Event Nurse at check-in on the day of the event. Any student found in possession of medication that was not checked in (whether prescribed or non-prescribed) may be sent home immediately.

MEALS & MERCH

Everyone attending The Hike will need to eat breakfast before arriving at check-in on Saturday. While we are at The Hike, lunch is included in the cost of registration. During registration, students can order an add-on The Hike shirt if they wish, but it's important to note that shirts are available on a first-come, first-served basis while supplies and sizes last. If students wish to purchase any other Student Ministry merch, they will need additional spending money.

Pro-tip: If you're sending extra money with your student, consider giving them a pre-paid Visa, Mastercard, or American Express card, and make sure their name is written on it. We will accept card payments at The Hike, and pre-paid cards will help students avoid losing their spending money. However, please note that students will not be able to use third-party bank apps like CashApp, Venmo, Zelle, or PayPal to purchase merch at The Hike.

EVENT ACTIVITIES

Treks are designed so that students can spend the most time with their connect group while at The Hike and get to know their new friends as much as possible. Camp Cho-Yeh offers a ton of awesome activities that students will get to experience during their trek time on Saturday! PACKING LIST

- Skateboards, roller blades, scooters, etc.
- Tobacco, e-cigarettes, alcohol, drugs of any kind, etc.
- Knives, guns, spears, harpoons, weapons of any kind, etc.
- Small armies, large armies, plans to take over the world... unless you plan to take over the world for Jesus

RULES

These rules are not in place to bore students, but to ensure that they get the most out of their experience

- Honor all staff, adult leaders, and students
- No PDA (public OR private displays of affection)
- No cell phones
- No drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, weapons, water guns, water balloons, silly string, pranks, etc.
- Do not leave camp property for any reason
- When walking from place-to-place travel in groups of four or more
- Do not touch another student's belongings without the owner's permission

BEHAVIORS THAT COULD LEAD TO REMOVAL FROM EVENT

- Stealing
- Destruction of property
- Assault on another student or staffer
- Foul language
- Repeated disobedience to rules
- Sexual activity of any kind
- The possession of drugs, alcohol, firearms, fireworks, or pornography
- Improper use of any mobile device
